# Canada–Peru Free Trade Agreement (CPFTA) Rules of Origin

## **In Brief**

1. This memorandum has been revised in order to provide a link to the official version of the <u>Canada-Peru Free</u> <u>Trade Agreement (CPFTA) Rules of Origin Regulations</u>. The CPFTA Rules of Origin Regulations are no longer fully excerpted in this memorandum.

**CPFTA Rules of Origin Regulations** 

#### **Guidelines and General Information**

1. <u>Chapter Three: Rules of Origin</u> of the <u>CPFTA</u> contains the general rules of origin that set out the criteria to determine the originating status of a good, as well as other general conditions and requirements.

2. <u>Annex 301: Specific Rules of Origin</u> of the <u>CPFTA</u> sets out the product specific rules of origin that establish the point at which materials or components have undergone sufficient production within the free trade area for the good produced to be considered originating.
